

House Rules Zaalvoetbal Vereniging Rotterdamse Studenten

General rules

- All RS players have to own an Erasmus Sport-pass which is valid until the end of the season. The cost of the sport-pass is included in the membership fee.
- Payment of the membership fee is done through Clublink. After the registration, you will receive a mail with the payment link. If you already have a sport pass, this has to be communicated to the treasurer, so you will not get an invoice for the wrong amount.
- Members will usually be registered for a whole season as a match-playing member. It is however also possible to become a member for half a season, or a training member.
- The fee for every type of membership will be communicated by the board at the beginning of the season. Non-students will pay a higher fee than students of a university or university of applied sciences (hogeschool).
- In case the payment isn't made in time, the money will be automatically deducted from your account. Make sure the payments is made on time, and if the amount invoiced is wrong, let the board know as soon as possible. There will be multiple mails sent from Clublink as a reminder, before the automatic deduction goes through.
- Every player has to be registered as a player of RS before they can take part in games. This registration will only be done by the board if (a part of) the fee has been paid.
- Every match-playing member has to upload a picture to their profile on the voetbal.nl app. This way, the referee can check the players of each team.
- Amount of players at a futsal match: min. 5 and max. 12 players. It's the responsibility of the captain to arrange enough players. If there are no 5 players who can make it to a match, the captain WhatsApp group can be used to borrow players from other teams.
- The captain of each team has to download the "KNVB Wedstrijdzaken" app. This app can be used to submit the teamsheet for each match. It's recommended for every player to download this app as well. It's also recommended to download the "Voetbal.nl" app, which shows the standings and all the scores.
- If a team has to cancel a match (for example because of a lack of players), this has to be communicated with the secretary at least 14 days in advance. For the cancelation, a €50 charge will have to be paid to the KNVB by this team.
- For a non-show, or showing up late, the KNVB charges a €120 fine.
- Every fine from the KNVB will have to be paid by the team it applies to

Materials

- Everyone is responsible for their own kit. These can be bought from RS, and will be property of the player

- Our supplier is unable to take returns of the shirts. It's recommended to first fit on a shirt from a teammate to find the right size. The shirts are tight and quite small for their respective sizes. The board will also keep shirts in different sizes, that can be used to find the right fit.

Contribution to the club

- Every RS team will have to referee a match every once in a while. This will be communicated beforehand in a schedule which will be shared in the Captains group on WhatsApp. The board decides which team has to referee each match. The board will keep in account whether a team has a home match themselves that evening as well and how often a team has already provided a referee, to make it fair for every team. On average, every team will have to referee 2 or 3 times. The team will have to appoint someone themselves who will do it.

- If a team fails to find someone to referee a game, this has to be communicated to the board at least 3 days in advance. The costs of a replacement referee (€35) will be charged to this specific team. If the failure to find someone is communicated less than 3 days in advance, there will also be an additional fine of €15.

- Every first year member of RS can be asked for some other contribution to the club. This could be in the form of helping with events of Erasmus Sport or helping with tournaments organized by RS. This will be communicated at least one month in advance.

- For each event of RS and Erasmus Sport, members may be appointed by the board to help. When they can't show up themselves, they will have to arrange replacements, or pay a fine of €50.

Match preparation

- Make sure you are present at the match at least 15 minutes in advance. If you will be late, you have to communicate this to your captain on time.

- If your team doesn't have enough players, the captain has to ask for replacements from other teams. This can be done in the Captains Whatsapp group. It's recommended to do this at least 2 days before a match.

- Make sure the digital match form is completed on time (on the KNVB Wedstrijdzaken app), so the match can start on time. The captain is responsible for this. If the captain can't come to the match, he can still fill in the form. In an emergency, for example if the form hasn't been filled in just before the match and the captain can't be reached, a board member can also fill it in. So in this case, get into contact with a board member quickly.

During the match

- Make sure you are aware of the rules. These rules can be found on the website of the KNVB and will be sent to the captains annually.

- RS is a respectful association; so we expect our members to act in a respectful way. This means respect towards each other, to the opponent and to the referee. When misconduct is witnessed, this player will be talked to. If their behaviour doesn't change, this member will be suspended. The length of the suspension will be determined by the board.

- Fines that are accumulated during matches, through red cards or misconduct, will be paid by the individual player or the whole team (for example, a fine for a direct red card is €20).

After the match

- Clean up any mess left behind, such as empty bottles.
- Make sure the administration of the referee is correct, the captain is responsible for this.
- If the result of the match isn't correctly recorded, make the secretary aware of this.

Trainings

- Trainings are held on Thursday evening, from 18:00 to 20:00 at Sporthal Kralingen, Slaak 15, Rotterdam
- Trainings are accessible for RS members, both training members and match playing members
- There will always be a board member present, who ensures there are enough balls and bibs.
- The board member decides the rules (playing time, switching of teams etc.) depending on the amount of players present.
- Matches are 6 or 8 minutes, depending on how many teams there are, or can be decided by scoring 2 goals. A draw means both teams go off.
- If a team has won 3 matches in a row, this team also goes out.
- With any conflict, the board member will come up with a solution, to which everyone has to abide.
- Clean up any possible mess, such as empty bottles, after the training

The board

- The board currently consists of four people. They have the following functions: Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and General Board Member.
- Before the start of every new season, RS will look for new board members. In case someone is interested, this can be communicated to a current board member.

Social media

- The Facebook and Instagram pages of RS will be updated with highlights
- Pictures and videos of RS matches will be posted. It's possible that images of members can end up on the public pages of RS. If you prefer not to have your picture posted, let the board know. Additionally, the board would gladly receive any pictures/videos from players that can be put on social media.

Other

RS is partly sponsored by Café de Smitse. Members can go here after a match, and can get a voucher for a pitcher from a board member.
